
Form	Lyophilized
Storage Buffer	lyophilized with PBS, pH 7.4, contains 0.02% sodium azide.
Reconstitution	Reconstitute the lyophilized powder with deionized water (or equivalent) to an final concentration of 0.5 mg/mL.
Storage Instructions	The lyophilized product remains stable up to 1 year at -20 °C from date of receipt. Upon reconstitution, it can be stored for 2-3 weeks at 2-8 °C or for up to 12 months at -20 °C or below. Avoid freeze/thaw cycles.
Purification	Protein A affinity column

# **Background**

**Target Background :** Adalimumab (Humira) is a humanized monoclonal antibody that's approved by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration for the treatment of patients with rheumatoid arthritis, psoriatic arthritis, ankylosing spondylitis, Crohn's disease, ulcerative colitis, chronic psoriasis, hidradenitis suppurativa, and juvenile idiopathic arthritis. Adalimumab binds to the TNF- $\alpha$  (tumor necrosis factor-alpha), and blocks its interaction with TNF- $\alpha$  receptors, reducing the inflammatory response of autoimmune diseases.

Synonyms: Rabbit monoclonal to Humira
